Our Philosophy

Litchfield Jazz Camp has been a special place for musical and personal growth for 22 years. Our top-notch staff teach groups at all levels in a supportive, collaborative atmosphere. There is no pre-audition, and we embrace all learning styles. Your placement audition on arrival puts you in a combo that's just right for you. Some need-based scholarships are available.

STUDENTS

Students are instrumentalists and vocalists, ages 13 to adult, with most in their mid-teens. They come from New England, 30+ states and abroad. More than 20 countries have been represented. Weekly attendance is 70 - 140 with up to 24 combos working simultaneously. Campers have gone on to top colleges, winning scholarships and awards. Many are also winners of coveted competition prizes and reader's and critic's polls. Those who become pros can be seen at famous jazz clubs and festivals around the globe and many return to teach at Litchfield.

FACULTY

Our talented, caring faculty are on the Jazz Map. They teach at Columbia, Williams, The New School, Amherst, Manhattan, Jazz at Lincoln Center, Purchase College and many other respected institutions and record and tour internationally. CLASSES & PRIVATE LESSONS

Don Braden, Music Director, and his faculty guide students in performance, improvisation, theory, composition, arranging, jazz history and master classes. Electives include big bands, ear training, sight reading, Latin percussion, songwriting, basic piano, and picking the college that's right for you. Private lessons are available. In the bargain, you'll learn a lot about the business of music, money management, nutrition, and living a rewarding life.

Concerts, Jams & the Litchfield Jazz Festival

You'll have lots of listening and performing opportunities. Nightly faculty concerts are open to students and guests at no charge. Jams follow, and student combo concerts wrap up each week. A month of music is topped off by the renowned Litchfield Jazz Festival, July 28/29. Campers attend festival concerts, Artist Talks and perform themselves between Mainstage acts. They meet festival stars, collect autographs and have an unforgettable time.

RESIDENTIAL LIFE & CAMPUS

Litchfield Jazz Camp is hosted for the first time at The Gunnery, a boarding and day school founded in 1850 by Frederick Gunn, in picturesque Washington, CT. Just 2 hours North of NYC, the region is served by three major airports. Residential Life Assistants live in each dorm and are available whenever a student needs them. The Camp is licensed (with a perfect score) by the CT Department of Health. We have a resident nurse, an on-call physician, a relationship with a nearby hospital, and CPR certified staff.

COLLEGE NIGHT

Students and families look forward to College Night during the 3rd week of Camp. Representatives from outstanding music colleges and universities present a panel on courses, costs, scholarships, and more. A College Fair follows where campers meet college reps.

FITNESS & SPORTS ELECTIVES

The physical demands of jazz and life—and the rigors of the road for pros— call for a unique degree of fitness. The Camp has playing fields for sports like pick up soccer and Frisbee and two indoor basketball courts. Excellent catering is available with three nutritious meals a day for boarders and day students. Dietary restrictions are happily addressed.

TUITION & FEES

Residential students registered for multiple weeks receive weekend meals and overnights at no additional charge. 4 Weeks There is a \$100 upcharge for students registered for week 4 to cover Festival transportation and meals. Discounts are available for early registration (before January 10), siblings, and groups.

A \$350 deposit (non refundable) is due with registration. Final tuition balance (minus deposit) is due on or before May 1. A \$50 fee will be added to registrations and tuition balances received after May 1.
